On the west side of the house, you'll find the living room with a fireplace, offering views towards the southwest and stunning sunsets in the evenings. Additionally, the master bedroom with a terrace, a generous bathroom, and a walk-in closet are also situated on this side.

On the east side of the house, there are two spacious bedrooms, each with its own bathroom and terrace, making them perfect for guests or growing children. This side has its own entrance and can be closed off from the main house.

From the main dwelling, you have a view of the garden, which features a generously sized rectangular swimming pool measuring 14x3 meters—ideal for swimming laps. There is also a studio that can be customized to your preferences, whether as a guest studio or a home office.

The property offers parking space for multiple cars, and visitors can easily park on the wide and tranquil street.
